Instructions for use

On the turf:

Cut and discharge the grass.

Shake the can well before opening. Add water to the paint.

Dilute STADE LINE:

- 1 part STADE LINE to 3 - 5 parts (as desired) water for the first marking.

- up to 1 part STADE LINE to 8 parts water for daily marking.

1 litre of diluted paint will mark 50 m of 10 cm wide strip.

<u>Cleaning equipment</u>: with water. Clean the equipment well and soak the nozzle in water.

<u>Precautions</u>: Do not apply in driving rain or at temperatures lower than 5°C. Mix the can well before using. Protect from frost.
